Today's Krakowskie Przedmieście Street, before the war, did not reach the intersection with Kościuszki Street.

4, Boczna str.

The register does not show the owner of the house, but the list of properties located in the city of Olkusz from 1935 indicates Piotr Piłka²⁷⁶. Roman-Catholic families and one Jewish family lived there.

Berek-Hersz & Chana (Zysla) nee Abramowicz EJDELMAN/AJDELMAN and son Abram-Lejb

Berek-Hersz, son of Szmul Rubin & Chaja nee Ejdelman, born on 20.03.1867 in Olkusz, worker-carter. His wife Chana (Zysla) nee Abramowicz, daughter of Moszek & Estera nee Lewkowicz, born on 14.10.1871 in Wolbrom. They got married on 20.10.1899 in Wolbrom. Initially they lived at 7, Północna str. together with: daughter Rywka born on 24.06.1905 in Olkusz, son Chaskiel born on 20.10.1910, son Abram-Lejb born on 02.06.1913 in Olkusz and son-in-law (wrongly described in the register as "son") Boruch-Majer Kiwkowicz born on 06.05.1908 in Wolbrom. On 10.04.1934 Rywka and Boruch-Majer moved at 5, Żuradzka str. On 06.10.1937 parents with sons (Abram-Lejb noticed with the date 22.10.1937) moved at 4, Boczna str. On 20.10.1937 Chaskiel moved to Będzin.

Berek-Hersz & Chana were murdered during the war, deported from Olkusz in mid-June 1942 during the ghetto liquidation to the death camp and recorded on the partial deportation list under nos. 239-240²⁷⁷. Abram-Lejb's fate is unknown.

The register does not indicate the owner of the house, but in the list of properties located in the city of Olkusz from 1935 this address is added by hand among the machine-written entries and states Lajbus Najmark as an owner²⁷⁹. One Jewish family lived there.

Lajbuś & Rojza nee Kestenberg NAJMARK and daughter Rela & son Szlama and Jakób

Lajbuś, son of Icyk & Rachla nee Poznańska, born on 27.10.1897 in Będzin, from where moved to Olkusz, merchant. His wife Rojza nee Kestenberg, daughter of Moszek & Estera Gołda nee Erlich, born on January 1899 in Olkusz. They got married on 16.06.1926 in Olkusz, where their children were born: on 08.05.1926 son Szlama, on 25.05.1929 daughter Rela and on 10.09.1930 son Jakób. Initially they lived at 22 app. 5, Bóżniczna str., on 31.12.1934 they moved at 11, Boczna str.

Mother and three children were murdered during the war, deported from Olkusz in mid-June 1942 during the ghetto liquidation to the death camp and recorded on the partial deportation list under nos.. 663-666²⁸⁰. Lajbus' fate is unknown.

Lejbus' parents and brother Chaskiel lived at 1 app. 1, Augustjańska str. and sister Dwojra Chendla Waga lived at 26, Górnicza str. Rojza's mother with daughter Sura lived at 1 app. 4, Augustjańska str., sister Laja Kerner lived at 4, Górnicza str. and sister Rywka Rozenblum lived at 37, 3rd of May str.
